



## **MANAGER OF PARTNERSHIPS**

This position is part of the Council to Advance Hunting and the Shooting Sports and will help to advance national R3 efforts, with a focus on serving industry, nonprofit, and state partners.

### **Position Summary:**

This position works to advance a national movement focused on R3 of hunters and recreational target shooters. The Manager of Partnerships is responsible for growing and increasing strategic partnerships to advance R3 and conservation work, as well as support efforts to engage state and federal agencies.

### **Responsibilities:**

#### *R3*

- Grow strategic partnerships to advance R3 and conservation work.
- Provide support to partners – review plans, connect partners together, provide updates, and expand Council facilitation at the regional and national level.
- Provide support to regional R3 committees and attends regional meetings as appropriate.
- Assist with managing the National R3 Implementation Workgroup.
- Assist in development of resources to increase understanding of R3.

#### *Government Relationships*

- Assist in monitoring and engaging in legislative issues relevant to R3.

#### *Communications*

- Represents Council at key events at the state, regional, and national level.
- Work with Council staff to raise the Council's profile by generating content, responding to media requests, and ensure consistent branding and messaging.
- Help source and identify opportunities to communicate R3 success stories and testimonials.
- Promotes the National R3 Clearinghouse and online National R3 Community.

#### *Management*

- Monitor relevant grant activities and progress of R3 projects and activities.
- As needed, develop new sources of funding including grants and services for partners.
- Assist in development of annual applications to the M-MSCG program.
- Work to implement the business plan and ensure fulfillment of goals/metrics set annually.
- Assist in the management and implementation of the National R3 Symposium.
- Assist in supporting Council Board during meetings and other events as necessary.
