Since 2020, she has been leading a national effort to establish a USDA-funded wild bee monitoring network. This group has developed standardized methodologies for wild bee data collection and is now working in collaboration with the Xerces Society for Invertebrate Conservation, the USFWS Center for Pollinator Conservation, and additional partners to coordinate and support US native bee conservation efforts.
