She directs the Xerces Society's Endangered Species Program in which she oversees a team of 22 conservation biologists who engage in research, run community science programs, develop technical guidance, restore habitat, and advocate for the protection of imperiled species and their habitats, with efforts primarily focused on the conservation of monarchs and other butterflies, bumble bees and other wild bees, fireflies, and mollusks.
