In Colorado, Kansas, New Mexico, Oklahoma and Texas

## Industry Property Enrollment Form and Guidance

In 2025, a federal court vacated the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service's 2022 listing of the lesser prairie-chicken under the Endangered Species Act (ESA). As a result, the WAFWA has elected to offer existing CCAA Participants the option to enroll new/additional lands into the CCAA. By enrolling land in the CCAA, your company will benefit from the 'assurances' provided by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (Service). If the lesser prairie-chicken becomes listed again, your company's participation in the CCAA guarantees that the Service "will not require additional conservation measures nor impose additional land, water, or resource use restrictions, beyond those voluntarily agreed to and described in Section XII of the CCAA". These assurances only apply to CCAA enrolled lands.

The fee for land enrollment is **\$8.50 per acre**. At the company's discretion, this may be paid as a lump sum due within 30 days of invoicing or it may be paid in three installments over a three-year period. WAFWA offers the installment plan at no additional cost as a courtesy to our Participants. As a reminder, enrollment fees are non-refundable, but they may be used by the company to pay for future project mitigation costs.

Once the request is received, the Program Director will amend the company's Certificate of Inclusion, Exhibit A - Enrolled Property and will provide the company with an invoice. The requested lands will become officially enrolled upon receipt of the full (or first payment). At which time, the company may immediately start utilizing the enrollment benefits.
